FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This legislation directs school districts to have staff trained to administer naloxone spray in the event of an opioid overdose. There must be trained staff in the school when it is open to students, staff, or the public. Trained staff must also be present during each school sponsored event whether onsite or off school grounds. Additionally, all school bus drivers must also be trained.

The legislation also requires schools to have at least two doses of naloxone spray available on site and at school-sponsored events.

These services will be implemented by school districts and the Department of Health. The Department of Education and Early Development does not anticipate fiscal impact from this bill.
