Analysis

This bill allows educators who retire with a valid Alaska teaching certificate to receive a certificate that is good for life allowing the educator to work for up to 165 consecutive days in the State as a long-term substitute teacher. An applicability section is added stating that this Act applies to a contract or collective bargaining agreement that becomes legally binding on or after the effective date of this Act.
