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FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

**STATE OF ALASKA
2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION****Analysis**

This bill changes the makeup of the Local Boundary Commission (LBC) by increasing the number of members from five to six with the new member being appointed from the unorganized borough. This bill also changes the designation of chair of the commission from the member from the state-at-large to one member selected by the commission from among its members. This bill adds requirements that members from each judicial district, or from the unorganized borough, must maintain a principal place of abode and be registered to vote in a precinct in that district, or in the unorganized borough.

If enacted, the additional costs associated with this bill will be absorbed within the existing budget authority of the Division of Community and Regional Affairs.
