Analysis

The bill provides an address confidentiality option for peace officers, correctional officers, and victims of crimes involving domestic violence, stalking, or sexual assault, and their household members, through a substitute mailing address and mail forwarding service that would be managed by the Department of Administration. There is no fiscal impact to the Department of Public Safety, Violent Crimes Compensation Board.
