FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

The bill creates a new type of protective order to address workplace violence by adding a new article to Alaska Statute (AS) 18.65. Under the new article, section AS 18.65.875, an employer may file a petition against an individual the employer believes has committed an act of violence, or threatened violence, against the employer or an employee.

The bill amends AS 18.65.540 requiring the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to maintain the workplace violence protective orders in the central registry of protective orders, and peace officers to take reasonable steps to ensure the orders, modified orders, or dismissed orders are entered into the registry within 24 hours.

The Department of Public Safety (DPS) Division of Statewide Services (SWS) is responsible for maintaining the state's central registry of protective orders under AS 18.65.540. The Alaska Public Safety Information Network that houses the central registry will need to be modified programmatically to accept and maintain the workplace violence protective orders. Based on recent contractor costs for similar work, the DPS estimates it will require 200 hours of contractor work at \$140 per hour to complete the programming changes for a total one-time cost of \$28,000.
