FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

The bill makes substantive and conforming amendments to statutes relating to human and sex trafficking, prostitution, possession of child sexual abuse material, and sex offenses. The bill also amends state law to create a new type of protective order: workplace violence protective orders.

The Department of Public Safety (DPS) Alaska State Troopers are responsible for the enforcement and investigation of the criminal laws proposed in this bill. The DPS does not anticipate a significant fiscal impact at this time and a zero fiscal note is being submitted.
