FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

Analysis

This bill adds civics education and assessment to the list of secondary school graduation requirements. Students must receive a passing score of 70 percent or more in order to receive a secondary school diploma. The student's passing score shall be noted on the student's official transcript.

This fiscal note contains the following one-time expenses: 1) \$270.0 for a facilitator to convene 20 educators and qualified stakeholders for their participation in the development of a civics assessment and corresponding secondary school semester long civics course/curriculum, including stipends, travel, and facilitation fees; and 2) \$6.0 for legal fees to implement the necessary regulation changes.
