FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

The bill amends Alaska statute by reclassifying the crime of illegally manufacturing or delivering a controlled substance that directly results in a person dying from *Manslaughter* (class A felony) to *Murder in the second degree* (unclassified felony). The Department of Family and Community Services, Division of Juvenile Justice serves juvenile offenders based upon their needs and risk to reoffend. The bill will have no fiscal or programmatic impact on the division.
