FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

Analysis

This legislation would make Alaska a member state of the Audiology and Speech-Language Interstate Compact (ASLP-IC or “compact”), which would allow Alaska’s audiologists (AUDs) and speech-language pathologists (SLPs) with unencumbered licenses who have had no adverse action against their license within two years to apply for and work under compact privilege in any other member states; and would allow the same for AUDs and SLPs meeting the same requirements in Alaska.

If the bill passes, the division will absorb the printing, postage, and legal costs of the associated regulations to conform with statutory changes. The division does not anticipate any additional fiscal impact from this legislation.

Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065. The total amount of revenue collected approximately equals each occupation’s actual regulatory costs. Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services – fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF).
