2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This legislation changes existing individual assistance program statutes by creating an if/when decision structure with different payment options depending on a federal presidential disaster declaration. It also establishes a fixed dollar amount for payment when no presidential disaster is declared and allows for individual assistance payments to be used to meet a unit owner's common expense liability associated with a disaster.

The proposed new advanced structure creates complex decision points, making it difficult to calculate the exact impact it would have on costs relating to the individual assistance program.

Therefore, the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs submits this indeterminate fiscal note.
