Senate Judiciary Committee: Version R to Version D

Page 5, line 10

- Adding new paragraph (9) to AS 21.23.260 that states "require that a third-party service provider that has access to or holds nonpublic information notify the insurer of a cybersecurity event involving nonpublic information as soon as possible and not later than three business days after the third-party service provider determines that a cybersecurity event has occurred; for purposes of this paragraph, encrypted nonpublic information is not considered accessible to or held by the third-party service provider if the associated protective process or key necessary to assign meaning to the nonpublic information is not within the possession of the third-party service provider;"
