3 **** Sec. 2.** AS 15.13.040(g) is amended to read:

4 (g) The provisions of (a), (b), and (l) of this section do not apply to a
5 (1) delegate to a constitutional convention, a judge seeking judicial
6 retention, or a candidate for election to a municipal office under AS 15.13.010, if that
7 delegate, judge, or candidate

8 (A) [(1)] indicates, on a form prescribed by the commission, an
9 intent not to raise and not to expend more than \$5,000 in seeking election to
10 office, including both the primary and general elections;

11 (B) [(2)] accepts contributions totaling not more than \$5,000 in
12 seeking election to office, including both the primary and general elections;
13 and

14 (C) [(3)] makes expenditures totaling not more than \$5,000 in
15 seeking election to office, including both the primary and general elections;

16 (2) group, if the group

17 (A) indicates, on a form prescribed by the commission, an
18 intent not to raise and not to expend more than \$5,000 in a calendar year;

19 (B) accepts contributions totaling not more than \$5,000 in a
20 calendar year; and

1 (m) Information required under this chapter shall be submitted to the
 2 commission electronically, except that the following information may be submitted in
 3 clear and legible black typeface or hand-printed in dark ink on paper in a format
 4 approved by the commission or on forms provided by the commission:

5 (1) information submitted by [(A)] a candidate for election to a
 6 borough or city office of mayor, membership on a borough assembly, city council, or
 7 school board, or any state office, who

8 (A) [(i)] meets the requirements of (g)(1) [(g)(1) - (3)] of this
 9 section;

10 (B) [OR (ii)] does not have reasonable access to the technology
 11 necessary to file electronically; in this subparagraph [SUB-
 12 SUBPARAGRAPH], a candidate is considered not to have reasonable access
 13 to the technology necessary to file electronically if the candidate does not own
 14 a personal computer or does not have broadband Internet access at the
 15 candidate's residence; in this subparagraph [SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH],
 16 "broadband Internet access" means high-speed Internet access that is always on
 17 and that is faster than traditional dial-up access; or

18 (C) [(B)] a candidate for municipal office for a municipality
 19 with a population of less than 15,000; in this subparagraph, "municipal office"
 20 means the office of an elected borough or city

21 (i) mayor; or

22 (ii) assembly, council, or school board member;

23 (2) information submitted by a group that meets the requirements
 24 of (g)(2) of this section; or

25 (3) any information if the commission determines that circumstances
 26 warrant an exception to the electronic submission requirement."
