1 Page 1, line 2, following "state;": *(title amendment)*:

2 Insert "limiting contributions and independent expenditures from nonresident
3 persons that are intended to influence the outcome of a ballot proposition election;"

5 Page 2, following line 19:

6 Insert a new bill section to read:

7 "* Sec. 4. AS 15.13.065(c) is amended to read:

8 (c) Except for reports required by AS 15.13.040 and 15.13.110, [AND
9 EXCEPT FOR] the requirements of AS 15.13.050, 15.13.060, and 15.13.112 -
10 15.13.114, and the limit in AS 15.13.072(i), the provisions of AS 15.13.010 -
11 15.13.116 do not apply to limit the authority of a person to make contributions to
12 influence the outcome of a ballot proposition. In this subsection, in addition to its
13 meaning in AS 15.80.010, "proposition" includes

14 (1) an issue placed on a ballot to determine whether

15 (A) a constitutional convention shall be called;

16 (B) a debt shall be contracted;

17 (C) an advisory question shall be approved or rejected; or

18 (D) a municipality shall be incorporated;

19 (2) an initiative proposal application filed with the lieutenant governor
20 under AS 15.45.020."

6 contributions from an

7 (1) individual who is not a resident of the state at the time the
8 contribution is made; or

9 (2) entity organized under the laws of another state.

10 *** Sec. 11.** AS 15.13.074 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

11 (j) A person who is not a resident of the state may not contribute more than
12 \$500 each year in total to all groups and nongroup entities for the purpose of
13 influencing the outcome of an election concerning a ballot proposition.

14 *** Sec. 12.** AS 15.13.084 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

15 (b) A person who is not a resident of the state may not make independent
16 expenditures of more than \$500 each year for or against a ballot proposition."
