1 * **Sec. 6. FUND CAPITALIZATION.** (a) The sum of \$40,000,000 is appropriated from the
2 general fund to the disaster relief fund (AS 26.23.300(a)).

3 (b) The sum of \$35,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the disaster relief
4 fund (AS 26.23.300(a)).

5 * **Sec. 7. FUND TRANSFERS.** The following amounts are appropriated to the general fund
6 from the sources indicated:

7 (1) the amount collected for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, estimated to
8 be \$6,080,000, from the surcharge levied under AS 43.55.300; and

9 (2) the amount collected for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, estimated to
10 be \$6,100,000, from the surcharge levied under AS 43.40.005.

11 * **Sec. 8. CONSTITUTIONAL BUDGET RESERVE FUND.** (a) If, after the appropriations
12 made to the general fund in this Act, the unrestricted state revenue available for appropriation
13 in fiscal year 2026 is insufficient to cover the general fund appropriations that take effect in
14 fiscal year 2026 that are made in this Act, as passed by the Thirty-Fourth Alaska State
15 Legislature in the Second Regular Session and enacted into law, the amount necessary to
16 balance revenue and general fund appropriations that take effect in fiscal year 2026 that are
17 made in this Act, as passed by the Thirty-Fourth Alaska State Legislature in the Second
18 Regular Session and enacted into law, not to exceed \$15,000,000, is appropriated to the
19 general fund from the budget reserve fund (art. IX, sec. 17, Constitution of the State of
20 Alaska).

21 (b) The appropriations made from the budget reserve fund (art. IX, sec. 17,
22 Constitution of the State of Alaska) in (a) of this section are made under art. IX, sec. 17(c),
23 Constitution of the State of Alaska.

24 * **Sec. 9. LAPSE.** (a) The appropriations made in sec. 1 of this Act are for capital projects
25 and lapse under AS 37.25.020.

26 (b) The appropriations made in sec. 6 of this Act are for the capitalization of a fund
27 and do not lapse.

28 * **Sec. 10. CONTINGENCY.** The appropriation made in sec. 6(b) of this Act is contingent
29 on the state's match rate as of June 30, 2026, remaining at 25 percent of the state's costs for
30 disaster relief under the Federal Emergency Management Agency's major disaster declaration
31 for the state because of Typhoon Halong (FEMA-4893-DR).

1 * **Sec. 11.** Sections 7 and 8 of this Act take effect June 30, 2026.

2 * **Sec. 12.** Except as provided in sec. 11 of this Act, this Act takes effect immediately under

3 AS 01.10.070(c)."
