A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act establishing World War II Victory Day."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to article 2 to read:

4 **Sec. 44.12.197. World War II Victory Day.** World War II Victory Day is
5 established on May 8 of each year to celebrate the victory of the Allied powers in
6 World War II and honor the sacrifices made by the brave men and women in the
7 United States military who fought for that victory. World War II Victory Day may be
8 observed by suitable observances and exercises by civic groups and the public.
