A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to minimum paid sick leave requirements for individuals employed in**
2 **seasonal seafood processing."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 23.10.069 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (d) Employment of seasonal seafood processing workers is exempt from the
6 requirements of AS 23.10.066 - 23.10.068. In this subsection, "seasonal seafood
7 processing worker" means an employee who is hired for a specific period related to
8 peak business need, not to exceed six months in each calendar year, to perform work
9 involving heading, gutting, separating, filleting, canning, or other activities intended to
10 prepare seafood for market.
