**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to funding for residential schools."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** AS 14.16.200(b) is amended to read:

4 (b) Costs that may be claimed by a district for reimbursement under (a) of this  
5 section are

6 (1) one round trip on the least expensive means of transportation  
7 between the student's community of residence and the school during the school year if  
8 the district expends money for the trip; and

9 (2) a per-pupil monthly stipend to cover room and board expenses as  
10 determined by the department on a regional basis and not to exceed the following  
11 amounts:

12 (A) for the Southeast Region (Region I), \$1,549 [\$1,230];

13 (B) for the Southcentral Region (Region II), \$1,512 [\$1,200];

14 (C) for the Interior Region (Region III), \$1,829 [\$1,452];

15 (D) for the Southwest Region (Region IV), \$1,901 [\$1,509];

1 (E) for the Northern Remote Region (Region V), \$2,237  
2 [\$1,776].
