**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Proposing amendments to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to terms of**  
2 **legislators.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** Article II, sec. 3, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended to read:

5 **Section 3. Election and Terms.** Legislators shall be elected at general  
6 elections. Their terms begin on the fourth Monday of the January following election  
7 unless otherwise provided by law. The term of representatives shall be two years, and  
8 the term of senators, four years. One-half of the senators shall be elected every two  
9 years. **No person who has served as a representative for six full terms shall again**  
10 **be eligible to be nominated, elected, or appointed to that office. No person who**  
11 **has served as a senator for three full terms shall again be eligible to be**  
12 **nominated, elected, or appointed to that office.**

13 \* **Sec. 2.** Article XV, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended by adding a new  
14 section to read:

15 **Section 30. Application of 2026 Tenure Amendment.** Years served in the  
16 legislature before the convening of the First Regular Session of the Thirty-Fifth

1 Alaska State Legislature shall not be considered for purposes of applying the tenure  
2 limit added by the 2026 amendment to Section 3 of Article II.

3 \* **Sec. 3.** The amendments proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of  
4 the state at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the  
5 State of Alaska, and the election laws of the state.
