A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to a report regarding involuntary commitment orders."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section
4 to read:

5 REPORT OF THE SUPERIOR COURT REGARDING INVOLUNTARY
6 COMMITMENT. By December 31, 2026, the superior court shall transmit the information
7 under AS 47.30.907(a) that has not been previously reported to the Department of Public
8 Safety for all orders of the superior court issued for the involuntary commitment of a person
9 under AS 47.30.735 - 47.30.755 or for orders of relief from a disability resulting from an
10 involuntary commitment or an adjudication of mental illness or mental incompetence granted
11 under AS 47.30.851(b).
