A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to municipal regulation of automated traffic safety cameras."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 29.10.200 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

4 (68) AS 29.35.143 (regulation of automated traffic safety cameras).

5 * **Sec. 2.** AS 29.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

6 **Sec. 29.35.143. Automated traffic safety cameras.** (a) A municipality with a
7 population of 25,000 or more may not ban the use of automated traffic safety cameras.

8 (b) This section applies to home rule and general law municipalities.

9 (c) In this section, "automated traffic safety camera" means a device that uses
10 a vehicle sensor installed to work in conjunction with an intersection traffic control
11 system, a railroad grade crossing control system, or a speed measuring device, and a
12 camera synchronized to automatically record one or more sequential photographs or
13 electronic images of the front or rear of a motor vehicle at the time the vehicle fails to
14 stop when facing a steady red traffic control signal or an activated railroad grade
15 crossing control signal, or exceeds a speed limit as detected by a speed measuring
