1 **Suspending Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State**  
2 **Legislature, concerning House Bill No. 69, relating to education; relating to open**  
3 **enrollment in public schools; relating to school and student performance reports;**  
4 **relating to school and district accountability; relating to charter schools; relating to an**  
5 **annual report for correspondence study programs; relating to the base student**  
6 **allocation; relating to reading proficiency incentive grants; relating to wireless**  
7 **telecommunications devices in public schools; relating to the duty of the legislature to**  
8 **pass a public education appropriation bill; relating to the duty of the governor to**  
9 **prepare a public education appropriation bill; establishing the Task Force on Education**  
10 **Funding; and relating to a report on regulation of school districts.**

11 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 relating to an annual report for correspondence study programs; relating to the base student  
5 allocation; relating to reading proficiency incentive grants; relating to wireless  
6 telecommunications devices in public schools; relating to the duty of the legislature to pass a  
7 public education appropriation bill; relating to the duty of the governor to prepare a public  
8 education appropriation bill; establishing the Task Force on Education Funding; and relating  
9 to a report on regulation of school districts.
