A RESOLUTION

1 **Authorizing the Senate and the House of Representatives to recess for a period of more**
2 **than three days.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **WHEREAS** art. II, sec. 10, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that neither
5 house of the legislature may adjourn or recess for longer than three days unless the other
6 house concurs; and

7 **WHEREAS** Rule 52, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, provides that
8 adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the full membership of each house
9 constitutes concurrence;

10 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Alaska State Legislature that the Senate and the House of
11 Representatives may each recess for a period of more than three days during the First Special
12 Session of the Thirty-Fourth Alaska State Legislature.
