FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

This bill requires the Child Support Enforcement Division to provide the Permanent Fund Dividend (PFD) Division with a list of individuals in arrears under a child support order by March 31 of each year.

This bill requires the PFD Division to file on behalf of another adult that owes child support. This legislation removes the signing of the application for eligibility determination, and allows the individual owed child support to submit residency evidence.

This bill also requires the PFD Division to deduct seven percent of a dividend distributed for child support to be deposited into the general fund, and provides that the legislature may appropriate this revenue for administrative costs incurred in implementing this new process.

Dividends collected for child support may not be donated or contributed to other programs, and the Department of Family and Community Services, the Alaska Commission on Post Secondary Education, the Department of Health, the Department of Labor and Workforce Development, and the University of Alaska may not claim a PFD that is owed to a child support order.

This bill requires further study to determine costs for additional personnel, printing and postage, and programming costs to make these changes.
