FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

HB 182 amends statutes relating to brewery, winery, and distillery retail licenses by limiting live music events or other entertainment performances to four events in a calendar year.

Based on 2024 data, the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office (AMCO) projects \$5.0 in reduced revenue annually as a result of the elimination of brewery, winery, and distillery retailer permit fees for live music events or other entertainment performances.

The Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office does not anticipate fiscal impact on operations if this legislation passes.
