FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2026 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This legislation would require the Department of Revenue to work with the Division of Elections to provide a report to the Governor and the Legislature on or before the first day of each regular session of the number of applicant records shared, the effect that had on voter roll maintenance and on election integrity; and security measures taken to protect voter information.

This legislation requires the Permanent Fund Dividend Division to update both paper and online applications to inform applicants of their right to opt out of registering to vote and their ability to update their voter registration. This change would take effect beginning with the 2027 PFD applications.

This legislation also changes the frequency and the type of application data the department currently provides to the Division of Elections.

There would be one-time programming costs associated with the implementation of the proposed legislation due to the new dividend application information system being implemented in 2026, but future costs are currently indeterminant because the cost of running such reports and maintaining the system on the Division's new Dividend Application Information System (DAIS) is currently unknown.
