FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill separates the Cook Inlet set gillnet permit holder category into two new administrative areas. The Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) would need to amend regulations for the Cook Inlet Central District, Upper Subdistrict to establish the new administrative area based on the statistical areas outlined in the bill.

The costs to adopt regulation changes can be absorbed. Therefore, the department submits a zero fiscal note.
