FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2026 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This legislation establishes a standard designation for evacuation language to be used in plans and regulations formulated under the Alaska Disaster Act (AS 26.20)

These changes would require emergency plans prepared under this section to use the designations set forth in the proposed statute change for use in evacuation maps and other public message as:

Level 1 Ready - indicated in green, to alert the public that an emergency may exist in the area;

Level 2 Set - indicated in yellow, to alert the public that evacuation of the area is imminent;

Level 3 Go indicated in red, to alert the public that a dangerous hazard exists and that an individual in the area should immediately evacuate.

DMVA does not anticipate any fiscal impact from the legislation as currently drafted.
