FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA  
2026 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill moves the Controlled Substances Advisory Committee (CSAC) from the Department of Law (LAW) to the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED).

The responsibilities of the CSAC are described in AS 11.17.100 and 11.71.110. While only a portion of these statutes are adjusted in this legislation, the relocation of the CSAC to DCCED shifts the responsibilities outlined in these statutes from LAW to DCCED.

The CSAC has a variety of responsibilities, including advising the Governor on changes to the controlled substance schedules in statute, and making recommendations to various other State of Alaska departments and boards on programs, regulations, and practices related to the enforcement of laws related to controlled substances, and treatment for individuals who abuse controlled substances. The CSAC also is charged with reviewing budget requests and recommending appropriations to the Governor for those purposes.

To accomplish this work, the CSAC is statutorily required to meet twice per year. This fiscal note projects one in-person meeting per year for all nine members of the board, as the location of CSAC members and the location for meetings in future years is not known. Travel support and reconciliation and minimal administrative support will be provided from the Commissioner's Office. General funds will be needed to support these costs.

If this legislation is adopted, the following costs will be incurred by the department:

**Travel:**            \$13.5            One trip per year for nine members (\$1.5 per traveler per trip)
