Thirty-first Day

Pursuant to adjournment the Senate was called to order by President Stevens at 10:45 a.m.

The roll showed seventeen members present. Senators Dunbar, Merrick, Olson were excused from a call of the Senate.

The prayer was offered by the Chaplain, Major Petr Janousek, The Salvation Army. Senator Hoffman moved and asked unanimous consent the prayer be spread. Without objection, it was so ordered.

Following his address, there was a question and answer period. Representative Begich received a standing ovation.

Senator Giessel moved and asked unanimous consent the Joint Session stand in adjournment. Without objection, President Stevens adjourned the Joint Session at 11:47 a.m.
