Each day, we traveled across lands owned by multiple private landowners, including Afognak Native Corporation, Koniag Regional Corporation, and Ouzinkie Native Corporation. The first day was focused on logistics and touring the logging camp infrastructure operated by Ouzinkie and Afognak Native Corporations. On days 2-5, we covered hundreds of miles of logging roads to review over 40 years of logging history, replanting efforts, and timber stand improvement projects. Over the course of days 2-5, we crossed properties belonging to three different private landowners and drove roads that belong to the state of Alaska. We concluded the trip with a visit to the sort yard, demonstrating the longshoring process used to load log ships for export to China. Since China banned timber imports, we have had approximately 6.5 million board feet of timber sitting on the ground ready for market, but no buyers, as Chinese importers have refused shipments in retaliation for U.S. tariff increases.
