6 For an Act entitled: "An Act outlining the ~~provisions~~ <sup>organization and procedure</sup> of Political  
7 ~~Parties~~ <sup>Parties</sup> ~~Organizations~~"

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

9 Section 1. GENERAL AUTHORITY. Each political party  
10 organization shall have power to:

- 11 (1) Make its own rules and regulations.
- 12 (2) Call conventions.
- 13 (3) Elect delegates to conventions, ~~Territorial and~~ <sup>unless otherwise provided</sup>

14 ~~National~~

- 15 (4) Fill vacancies on the ticket.
- 16 (5) Perform all functions inherent in such an organization

17 Provided, that in no instance shall any convention have the  
18 power to nominate any candidate to be voted for at any primary  
19 election.

20 Section ~~2~~ <sup>3</sup> TERRITORIAL CENTRAL COMMITTEE. The Territorial  
21 Central Committee of each political party shall consist of one  
22 committeeman and one committeewoman from each division elected by  
23 the divisional committee at its organizational meeting; <sup>Full National</sup> It shall

24 Have a chairman and vice-chairman who must be of opposite sexes,

25 Section ~~3~~ <sup>4</sup> DIVISIONAL CENTRAL COMMITTEE. The Divisional  
26 Central Committee of each political party shall consist of the  
27 precinct committeemen and committeewomen from the several voting  
28 precincts in the division. This committee shall meet for the  
29 purpose of organization on the sixth Saturday after the holding

1 of the primary elections in the principal city in the division  
2 at an exact hour and place to be set by the chairman of the  
3 outgoing Divisional Central Committee. Notice <sup>of the place</sup> ~~of the place and~~  
4 ~~hour of meeting~~ shall be mailed to all newly elected precinct  
5 committeemen and committeewomen at least 15 days before the date  
6 on which the committee ~~is to~~ convene. At its organizational  
7 meeting the Divisional Central Committee shall elect a chairman  
8 and vice-chairman, who must be of opposite sexes, and the  
9 ~~Committeemen and committeewomen members for the Division of the~~  
10 ~~Territorial Central Committee.~~ For the purposes of calling the  
11 first divisional committee meetings after the 1954 primary  
12 election, the persons acting as divisional committeemen of each  
13 political party at the time of first elections of precinct  
14 committeemen and committeewomen shall act as temporary chairmen  
15 until permanent chairmen are elected.

17 *and a Divisional Committeeman in the Division*  
18 *to act as a temporary chairmen in the*  
19 *Divisional Central Committee. There shall be*  
20 *at least one woman among the members of the committee*  
21 *at each organizational meeting, and only such interested*  
22 *persons as are members of the committee shall*  
23 *be permitted to participate, and provision*  
24 *shall be made only to committeemen and*  
25 *committeewomen residing within the same*  
26 *precinct district as the absent persons.*
