IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act pertaining to privileges of the members of the Legislature; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. No member of the Legislature shall be required to appear in any court as witness, attorney or party during his attendance upon the sessions of the respective houses, and any case, either civil or criminal, in which a member of the Legislature is either a necessary witness, attorney of record for either party, or plaintiff or defendant shall be postponed until after the session of the Legislature shall have terminated and for at least twenty days thereafter.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
