HOUSE BILL NO. 30

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the sale or the offer for sale, of ~~jewelry consisting in part~~ imitation gold nuggets, <sup>Alaskan gold or</sup> ~~unless properly~~ <sup>unless properly</sup> ~~labeled, and providing penalty therefor,~~ <sup>and declaring an emergency."</sup>

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

~~Section 1. "Imitation gold nuggets", as used in this Act, shall be deemed to mean nuggets cast or otherwise manufactured from gold in a form so as to imitate gold nuggets in their natural state.~~

~~Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or offer to sell jewelry in which is incorporated as a part thereof imitation gold nuggets, or nuggets manufactured of any other material whatsoever, without having a label affixed thereto, setting forth in legible type or writing that the nuggets used in the manufacture of said jewelry are imitation gold nuggets, or other material, as the case may be.~~

~~Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating this Act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.~~

~~Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.~~
