HOUSE BILL NO. 68

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing Legislative Districts for the election of members of the Territorial House of Representatives."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, acting under and by virtue of the power and authority granted in the Organic Act, do hereby establish the districts from which the members of the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska shall be elected, in accordance with the number of inhabitants, as herein set forth.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall consist of twenty-four members who shall be elected from twenty-four representative districts herein established, and said representative districts are hereby created, constituted and numbered as follows:

FIRST JUDICIAL DIVISION

District No. 1. Ketchikan town.

District No. 2. Ketchikan Recording District outside of Ketchikan town.

District No. 3. Wrangell, Hyder and Petersburg Recording Districts.

District No. 4. Sitka Recording District.

District No. 5. Juneau city.

District No. 6. Juneau Recording District

1 outside Juneau city, and Haines
2 and Skagway Recording Districts.

3 **SECOND JUDICIAL DIVISION**

4 District No. 1. Roatak-Kobuk and Fairhaven
5 Recording Districts.

6 District No. 2. That portion of Cape Nome Re-
7 cording District lying North of
8 64° N. latitude, plus the Koyuk
9 Recording District.

10 District No. 3. That portion of the Cape Nome
11 Recording District lying South
12 of 64° N. latitude, plus Wade
13 Hampton Recording District.

14 **THIRD JUDICIAL DIVISION**

15 District No. 1. Kodiak, Aleutian Islands and
16 Unga Peninsula Recording Dis-
17 tricts.

18 District No. 2. Homer, Seldovia, Kvichak, Iliamna
19 and Bristol Bay Recording Dis-
20 tricts.

21 District No. 3. Cordova, McCarthy, Valdez,
22 Chitina, Talkeetna and Wasilla
23 Recording Districts, and that
24 portion of the Palmer Recording
25 District lying east of 149° W.
26 longitude.

27 District No. 4. Seward and Whittier Recording
28 Districts, that portion of
29 Anchorage Recording District

1 lying south of 61° N. latitude,
2 and that portion of Anchorage
3 Recording District lying west
4 of $150^{\circ} 5'$ W. longitude.

5 District No. 5. That portion of Palmer Recording
6 District lying west of 149° W.
7 longitude and that portion of
8 Anchorage Recording District
9 lying north of $61^{\circ} 14'$ N. lati-
10 tude and east of $150^{\circ} 5'$ W. Long-
11 itude.

12 District No. 6. That portion of Anchorage Re-
13 cording District east of $150^{\circ} 5'$
14 W. longitude which lies south of
15 $61^{\circ} 14'$ N. latitude and north of
16 $61^{\circ} 13'$ N. latitude, but not
17 including any part of Anchorage
18 city.

19 District No. 7. That portion of Anchorage Re-
20 cording District east of $150^{\circ} 5'$
21 W. longitude which lies north of
22 61° N. latitude and south of 61°
23 $11'$ N. latitude.

24 District No. 8. That portion of Anchorage Re-
25 cording District east of $150^{\circ} 5'$
26 W. longitude which lies north of
27 $61^{\circ} 11'$ N. latitude and south of
28 $61^{\circ} 13'$ N. latitude but not in-
29 eluding any part of Anchorage

city.

Districts Nos. 9 & 10. Anchorage city. (Two members to be elected at large).

FOURTH JUDICIAL DIVISION

District No. 1. Bethel and Kuskokwim Recording Districts.

District No. 2. Mount McKinley, Innoko, Otter, Nulato, Nenana, Fort Gibbon, Hot Springs, Tolovana, Rampart, Koyukuk, Circle and Eagle Recording Districts, that portion of Fairbanks Recording District lying north of 66° N. latitude and that portion of Fairbanks Recording District lying west of $148^{\circ} 30'$ W. longitude.

District No. 3. Fairbanks city.

District No. 4. That portion of Fairbanks Recording District lying east of $147^{\circ} 50'$ W. longitude, west of $147^{\circ} 35'$ W. longitude, south of $64^{\circ} 55'$ N. latitude and north of $64^{\circ} 45'$ N. latitude but not including any part of Fairbanks city

District No. 5. That portion of Fairbanks Recording District lying west of $147^{\circ} 50'$ W. longitude, east of $147^{\circ} 35'$ W. longitude, north of $64^{\circ} 55'$ N. latitude and south of $64^{\circ} 45'$ N.

1 latitude, but excepting that
2 portion of Fairbanks Recording
3 District lying north of 66° N.
4 latitude and that portion lying
5 west of 148 30' W. longitude.

6 Section 3. The representatives provided for in this Act
7 shall be elected at the general election to be held on the
8 second Tuesday in October, 1954 and every two years thereafter.

9 Section 4. All acts and parts of acts in conflict here-
10 with are hereby repealed.
