HOUSE BILL NO. 64

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act making the obstructing of a public officer ^{peace} ~~in the discharge of his duties~~ ^{while making an arrest} a misdemeanor; and providing a penalty."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Every person who, ~~in any case under any~~ ^{peace} ~~circumstances not otherwise specially provided for,~~ ^{making} wilfully ~~resists, delays, or obstructs a public officer in discharging or~~ ^{making a lawful arrest} attempting to discharge any legal duty of his office shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment for not more than thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
