IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Sec. 51-5-2 (d) (3) AGLA 1949 pertaining to the definition of 'seasonal wage credits' and declaring ~~an~~ emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. That Sec. 51-5-2 (d) (3) is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 51-5-2 (d) (3) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions^{of} of the subsection, seasonal wage credits shall be available only with respect to weeks of unemployment occurring in whole or in part within the longest seasonal period (as determined pursuant to subsection (c) of this section) of the industry from which they were earned.

The term "seasonal wage credits" means wage credits based upon all wages for employment by employers (EARNED FROM A SEASONAL INDUSTRY DURING THE LONGEST SEASONAL PERIOD, AS DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (c) OF THIS SECTION.) during an individual's base year, provided that more than eighty (80%) per centum of such wage credits were earned for employment by employers in a seasonal industry.

Section 2, An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
