3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

4 TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to secure a new expression from
7 the voters of the Territory as to the
8 desirability of Alaska becoming a State."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. There shall be submitted to the voters of
11 the Territory of Alaska, at the next general election, the
12 question whether Alaska should become a State.

13 Section 2. There shall be given to each voter at said
14 general election, a separate ballot in substantially the follow-
15 ing form:

16 Statehood for Alaska, for _____

17 Statehood for Alaska, against _____

18 Section 3. The affirmative of the proposal as provided
19 for in Section 2 supra, shall be printed at the top in one-half
20 of the ballot and the negative at the top of the other half,
21 and an equal number of each form of ballot shall be distributed
22 in each of the voting precincts.

23 Section 4. The returns of the election shall be can-
24 vassed in the manner prescribed for general elections and the
25 result shall be certified and transmitted by the Secretary of
26 the Territory to the Legislature at the next regular session
27 in January, 1955, in order that the Legislature may take such
28 action as may be necessary in conformance with the result of
29 the referendum.
