HOUSE BILL NO. 64

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act making the obstructing of a ^{peace} public officer ^{while making an arrest,} ~~in the discharge of his duties~~ a misdemeanor; and providing a penalty."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Every person who, ~~in any case under any~~ circumstances ~~not otherwise specially provided for,~~ wilfully resists, ~~delays,~~ or obstructs a ^{peace} public officer ^{making} in discharging or attempting to discharge ~~any legal duty of his office~~ ^{make a lawful arrest} shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or imprisonment for not more than thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
