HOUSE BILL NO. 70

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An act providing for the preparation of wallet size identification cards for members of the legislature, authorizing expenditure from the existing "Emergency Appropriation" for the printing of such identification cards; authorizing the Governor to voucher for said purpose against said appropriation and the Treasurer to make payment therefor from said Appropriation; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. In view of the continued need for adequate, suitable and positive identification for members of the Territorial Legislature to carry on their person (for identification concerning legislative immunity during the legislative sessions or the traveling thereto or therefrom, for serving as proof of entitlement to apply for and receive Federal travel tax exemptions, for the purpose of identification to alleviate unnecessary inconvenience in establishing credit or cashing checks during the legislative session), there is hereby authorized for expenditure from the existing Emergency Appropriation, such amount as may be necessary for the printing of 200 copies of a wallet-size identification card for members of the legislature

15 Section 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon
16 passage and the members of the Twenty-first Legislative Session
17 shall each be furnished a duly certified identification card
18 substantially in the form outlined in Section 1. Hereafter
19 each newly elected member of subsequent legislatures shall, as
20 soon as possible after being certified as elected, be forwarded
21 a legislative identification card by the Secretary of Alaska by
22 registered mail with return receipt requested.

23 Section 3. The Governor of Alaska is hereby authorized to
24 take necessary steps to effect the purposes of this Act, and to
25 voucher against said appropriation for such printing expense;
26 and the Treasurer is hereby authorized to make payment from
27 said Appropriation for said purpose upon presentation in the
28 regular manner of a voucher drawn for such purpose.

29 Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and
30 this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its
31 passage and approval.
