A BILL repealing Section 35-3-42, ACCLA # 1949

5 For an Act entitled: "An Act ^{repealing Section 35-3-42, ACCLA # 1949} creating an Alaska Dental Exami-
6 ners Commission; and declaring an emer-
7 gency."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

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10 Section 1. Section 35-3-42, ACCLA 1949, is hereby repealed
11 and the Board of Dental Examiners created thereunder is hereby
12 abolished. Said Board of Dental Examiners hereinafter abolished
13 shall deliver to the Dental Examiners Commission, all such
14 property, books, papers, records and unexpended funds pertain-
15 ing to the business of said Board as are now in their possession
16 and under their control.

17 Section 2. DENTAL EXAMINERS COMMISSION: MEMBERS, THEIR
18 QUALIFICATIONS, APPOINTMENT AND TERMS: VACANCIES AND OATH OF
19 OFFICE. A Dental Examiners Commission for the Territory of
20 Alaska is hereby created. Such Commission shall consist of
21 five members who shall be appointed by the Governor, upon re-
22 commendation by the Alaska Dental Society and confirmed by ~~the~~
23 *a majority of the Senate and House in joint session assembled*
~~legislature~~, for a term of five years, except that vacancies
24 shall be filled by appointment ^{by the Governor upon recommendation} for the unexpired term. Initially,
25 one member shall be appointed for a term of one year, one member
26 for a term of two years, one member for three years, one member
27 for four years, and one for a term of five years. Thereafter,
28 all appointments or reappointments shall be for a full term of
29 five years. No two members of the Commission shall be graduates

1 of the same school of dentistry. Members shall serve until
2 their successors are duly appointed. No one shall be qualified
3 to serve as a member of the Commission unless he is a resident
4 of the Territory and duly registered as a dentist therein.
5 Before entering upon duty each member of the Commission shall
6 file with the Governor his oath of office to the effect that he
7 will faithfully and impartially discharge his duties as a member
8 of the Dental Examiners Commission. Initial appointments to the
9 Commission shall be made by the Governor within ten days after
10 the effective date of this Act.

11 Section 3. The Dental Examiners Commission shall have all
12 the powers, duties and functions formerly had and performed by
13 the Board of Dental Examiners as provided in Sections 35-3-41
14 through 35-3-55 ACLA 1949, inclusive, and wherever the word
15 "Board" or words "Board of Dental Examiners" occur therein the
16 word "Commission" or words "Dental Examiners Commission" shall
17 be substituted therefor.

18 Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and
19 this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its
20 passage and approval.
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
