HOUSE BILL NO. 86

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to authorize appointment by the Governor of a Commission to prepare and adjudge designs for submission to the Twenty-second Territorial Legislature for their selection of an official seal for Alaska.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The Governor of Alaska is hereby authorized and directed to appoint a Commission consisting of ^{three persons - a} ~~two recognized~~ ~~artist, an architect and a layman~~ ^{select} artists and one accredited architect to devise two proposed designs for an official Seal of Alaska for submission to the Twenty-second Legislature.

Section 2. Anticipating the prospect of territory-wide contests to be conducted by service or other organizations for the design of an official seal, said Commission is hereby directed to present ^{to the Twenty-second Legislature} ~~in addition to its own two designs, the~~ two designs which they adjudge the best ^{from all designs} ~~from such contests for~~ ~~submitted including their own.~~ submission to the Twenty-second Legislature.

Section 3. It is the intent and purpose of this Act that the Twenty-second Session of the Alaska Legislature shall, from the selection of designs choose an official Seal for Alaska.
