6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to providing aid to
7 dependent children; increasing the
8 maximum benefits therefor; defining
9 "Dependent Child" and "Assistance";
10 amending Section 51-2-33 ACLA 1949, as
11 last amended by Chapter 106 S.L.A. 1951;
12 and fixing an effective date."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

14 Section 1. Section 51-2-33 ACLA 1949, as last amended by
15 Chapter 106 S.L.A. 1951, is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 51-2-33. Amount of Assistance. The amount of
17 assistance which shall be granted for any dependent child,
18 and the relative with whom the dependent child is living,
19 shall be determined by the Welfare Department with due
20 regard to the resources and necessary expenditures of the
21 family and the condition existing in each case and shall
22 be sufficient, when added to all other income and support
23 available to the child, to provide (SUCH) the child and
24 relative with reasonable subsistence compatible with
25 decency and health; provided, however, that the amount of
26 assistance granted shall not exceed (SIXTY DOLLARS
27 (\$60.00)) eighty dollars (\$80.00) where there is a relative
28 and one child, and where there is more than one (SUCH)
29 child, the amount allowed for the relative and first child

shall not exceed (SIXTY DOLLARS (\$60.00)) eighty dollars
