6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to per diem and trans-
7 portation for members of Territorial
8 boards and commissions; and declaring an
9 emergency."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. From and after the effective date of this Act,
12 the following provisions relating to per diem and transportation
13 shall govern exclusively, and shall supersede all other
14 provisions of law, with respect to a member of any Territorial
15 board, commission, committee, or other similar body of persons of
16 the Territory organized or established under authority of law, *and*
17 who is otherwise entitled by law to receive from the Territory
18 payments for expenses of transportation and for reimbursement,
19 or for per diem in lieu of reimbursement, for other expenses,
20 incident to his duties as such member:

21 (a) With respect to transportation, such member shall
22 be entitled either to the use of Territorial transportation
23 requests, or to be reimbursed for expenses of transportation, to
24 the same extent, in the same manner and under the same conditions
25 as provided for Territorial officials and employees by the
26 provisions of subsections 3 and 4 of Section 11-4-1 ACLA 1949,
27 as amended or as hereafter amended.

28 (b) With respect to reimbursements for other expenses
29 such member shall be entitled to per diem ^{and compensation, shall} at the rate of \$20.00

per day for each day, or portion thereof, spent on official business incident to his duties as such member.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
