HOUSE BILL NO. 106

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act prescribing minimum uniform qualifications and procedure for filing for the elective offices of municipalities of the first class."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. All candidates for election to offices of municipalities of the first class shall file a declaration of candidacy, containing certain minimum qualifications, in the office of the municipal clerk of said municipality ^{at least seven} ~~on or before~~ ^{days} ~~the last Tuesday of September next~~ preceding the municipal election in which said candidate seeks to be elected. Such declaration of candidacy shall be accompanied by a filing fee of five dollars (\$5.00).

Section 2. The declaration of candidacy shall be in substantially the following form:

Section 3. All filing fees collected under this Act
shall belong to the municipality and be paid over to its
Treasury.

Section 4. The provisions of this Act shall not be con-
strued to prohibit municipalities from prescribing additional
rules, regulations and requirements not in conflict with
this Act.
