6 For an Act entitled: "An Act imposing additional duties on
7 mining recorders, providing for payment
8 for same, and declaring an emergency."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. The purpose of this Act is to enable the
11 Territorial Department of Mines to accumulate and disseminate
12 information on the status of mining ground in the performance
13 of its prescribed duties.

14 Section 2. The recorder of each recording precinct in
15 Alaska shall prepare and forward to the Commissioner of Mines
16 on the 1st day of each month a report of each instrument re-
17 corded affecting the title to or location of mining claims
18 during the preceding 30-day period.

19 Section 3. Payment shall be made to the recorder upon
20 receipt by the Department of Mines of the reports of the
21 transactions at the rate of one dollar each.

22 Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and
23 this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and
24 approval.
