6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend law relating to School  
7 Tax."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

9 Section 1. Section 37-4-1 is hereby amended to read as  
10 follows:

11 Section 37-4-1. TAX IMPOSED: PERSONS SUBJECT TO TAX;  
12 AMOUNT: PAYMENT. There is hereby imposed upon all male  
13 persons and all female persons except those who are un-  
14 employed and whose support is entirely dependent upon the  
15 income of their husbands and whose husband has paid a  
16 school tax for the current year, in this Territory or the  
17 waters thereof, over twenty-one and under fifty-five  
18 years of age, except those mentioned in the next following  
19 section, a school tax of (~~\$5.00~~) \$15.00 per year; all  
20 persons subject to said tax shall pay the same, upon  
21 demand, to the school tax collector between the first day  
22 of January and the first day of December of each year.  
23 Any person subject to said tax who shall fail or neglect  
24 to pay the same when demand for payment thereof is made,  
25 or if the school tax collector fails to demand or collect  
26 the same during that time, shall pay such tax at any time  
27 during that year to the school tax collector of the dis-  
28 trict in which he may be or to the Tax Commissioner at  
29 Juneau.

1 Section 2. Section 37-4-12 is hereby amended to read as  
2 follows:

3 Section 37-4-12. SCHOOL TAX RECEIPTS: FURNISHING TO  
4 COLLECTORS: COLLECTORS TO ACCOUNT FOR RECEIPTS AND MONEYS  
5 AND TO TURN OVER BOOKS AND RECORDS: DEPOSIT IN SCHOOL FUND.  
6 The Tax Commissioner shall furnish school tax collectors  
7 with printed blank school tax receipts, bound in book form,  
8 numbered and each having a stub containing the same number  
9 as the receipt to which it is affixed; the stub shall be  
10 wide enough to contain the date of delivery of the receipt,  
11 the name of the person to whom it is issued and the name  
12 of the one paying the tax. The Tax Commissioner shall  
13 sign and deliver such receipt to the school tax collectors  
14 who shall receipt therefor and countersign them and make  
15 an entry thereof in a book to be kept for that purpose.

16 Each receipt shall be filled out for (FIVE DOLLARS)  
17 the amount of the tax and said sum shall be charged to  
18 each collector for each receipt delivered to him. The  
19 Tax Commissioner shall give credit to the school tax  
20 collector for each receipt returned to him in blank at  
21 the time of his final settlement.

22 On the last day of each year and at the expiration of  
23 his term of office the collector shall account for all  
24 school tax receipts delivered to him and shall surrender  
25 all that remain in his possession unused and turn over to  
26 the Tax Commissioner all moneys remaining in his hands and  
27 all books and records kept by him during that year or his  
28 term of office.

29 All sums collected under the provisions of this Act
