6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to authorize the Employment Security
7 Commission to acquire land and buildings for
8 office space; amending Section 51-5-11 ACLA
9 1949; and declaring an emergency."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Section 51-5-11 ACLA 1949 is amended by adding
12 thereto subsection (m) to read as follows:

13 Section 51-5-11 (m). Acquisition of Land and Buildings.

14 (1) The Commission is authorized to acquire for and in the
15 name of the Territory by term purchase agreements such land
16 and buildings upon such terms and conditions as may be approved
17 by the Bureau of Employment Security of the United States, or
18 such other Federal Agency as shall hereafter perform its
19 functions, for the purpose of providing office space for the
20 Commission at such places as the Commission shall find
21 necessary and suitable.

22 (2) Any agreement made for the purchase of said premises
23 shall be subject to the approval of the Attorney General as
24 to form, and shall not subject the Territory to any liability
25 for the payment of such purchase price, or any part or portion
26 thereof, except from such moneys as may be allocated to the
27 Territory by the Bureau of Employment Security, or successor
28 thereto, for the administration of the Alaska Employment
29 Security Law.

(3) All moneys received from the United States for the payments authorized herein for such lands and buildings shall be deposited in the Unemployment Compensation Administration Fund in the Territorial treasury and are hereby appropriated therefrom for purposes of this Act.

(4) It is declared to be the policy of this Territory that in the event such premises are purchased pursuant to this Act, the Employment Security Commission, or such other department of the Territory as may hereafter perform its functions, shall be housed therein without further payment therefor by the United States; or if, in the future, it may be desirable to move said Employment Security Commission, other suitable similar space will be furnished by the Territory to said Commission without further payment therefor by the United States.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
