HOUSE BILL NO. 123

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to prohibit electioneering of any kind at or near polling places on election days."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. No person shall do any electioneering, circulate cards or handbills of any kind, post political signs or posters, hand out marked ballots, or solicit signatures to any <sup>political</sup> ~~kind of~~ petition on election day within any polling place, or any building in which an election is being held, or within <sup>one</sup> two hundred feet thereof, nor obstruct the doors or entries thereto, or prevent free ingress to and egress from said building. Whoever violates any provision of this Act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.
