HOUSE BILL NO. 126

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Section 16-1-35
(Fourteenth), ACLA 1949, relating to the
power of council with respect to the
regulation and taxation of peddlers,
hawkers, itinerant and transient vendors,
commercial travelers and bona fide sales
by sample for future delivery."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 16-1-35 (Fourteenth), ACLA 1949 is
hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 16-1-35, fourteenth. LICENSE TAX: CONTROL OF
VENDORS, ETC. To license, tax, restrain, or prohibit
peddling, hawking on or in the streets of the city or at
any public place therein; and the council may (IMPOSE) by
ordinance license, regulate and impose a reasonable
(LICENSE) tax on auctioneers, itinerant vendors and persons,
their principals and agents, engaged in a temporary or
transient business of vending or selling merchandise,
stocks or bonds or other articles of commerce within the
municipality; (BUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL
NOT APPLY TO ORDERS TAKEN BY COMMERCIAL TRAVELERS AND IN
THE USUAL COURSE OF BUSINESS OR TO BONA FIDE SALES OF MER-
CHANDISE OR GOODS BY SAMPLE FOR FUTURE DELIVERY.) further,
the council may license, regulate and impose a reasonable

1 tax upon canvassers or solicitors, defined herein to be
2 any individual traveling by any means of locomotion from
3 place to place, from house to house, or from street to
4 street, taking or attempting to take orders for the sale
5 of goods, wares and merchandise, or personal property of
6 any nature whatsoever for future delivery, or for service
7 to be furnished or performed in the future, whether or not
8 such individual has, carries or exposes for sale a sample
9 of the subject of such sale or whether he is collecting
10 advance payments on such sales or not, and such definition
11 shall also include any person who, for himself, or for
12 another person, firm, or corporation hires, leases, uses,
13 or occupies any building, structure, tent, hotel room,
14 lodging house, apartment, shop or any other place within
15 the city for the sole purpose of exhibiting samples and
16 taking orders for future delivery, provided, however, that
17 such definition shall not apply to any commercial traveler
18 or other person taking such orders from any retail esta-
19 blishment.
