HOUSE BILL NO. 127

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA
TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act defining and making prostitution, lewdness and assignation, and all acts aiding or abetting these practices, or any of them, illegal within the Territory of Alaska; providing penalties therefor; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Definitions: That the term "prostitution" shall be construed to include the giving or receiving of the body for sexual intercourse for hire, and shall also be construed to include the giving or receiving of the body for indiscriminate sexual intercourse; the term "lewdness" shall be construed to include any indecent or obscene act; and the term "assignation" shall be construed to include the making of any appointment or engagement for prostitution or lewdness or any act in furtherance of such appointment or engagement.

Section 2. That from and after the passage and approval of this Act, it shall be unlawful within the Territory of Alaska to engage in prostitution, lewdness, or assignation.

Section 3. That from and after the passage and approval of this act, it shall be unlawful within the Territory of Alaska to procure or to solicit, or to offer to procure or solicit for the purpose of prostitution, lewdness, or assignation.

Section 4. That from and after the passage and approval

1 of this act, it shall be unlawful within the Territory of
2 Alaska to receive or to offer or agree to receive any person
3 into any place, structure, building, boat, automobile, trailer,
4 or any other vehicle, for the purpose of prostitution, lewdness
5 or assignation, or to permit any person there to remain for
6 such purpose or purposes.

7 Section 5. That from and after the passage and approval
8 of this act, it shall be unlawful within the Territory of Alaska
9 to direct, take or transport, or to offer, or agree to take or
10 transport, any person to any place, structure, building, boat,
11 automobile, trailer, or other vehicle, for the purpose of
12 prostitution, lewdness or assignation.

13 Section 6. That from and after the passage and approval
14 of this act, it shall be unlawful within the Territory of Alaska
15 to reside in, enter, or remain in any place, structure, or
16 building, or to enter and remain in any boat, automobile,
17 trailer, or other vehicle for the purpose of prostitution, lewd-
18 ness or assignation.

19 Section 7. That any person convicted of violating any of
20 the provisions of this act shall be deemed guilty of a mis-
21 demeanor and shall be fined a sum not exceeding \$500.00, or
22 shall be imprisoned in jail not exceeding ninety (90) days,
23 or both.

24 Section 8. That if any portion of this act shall be
25 declared unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the
26 validity of the remaining portions or sections of this act.

27 Section 9. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and
28 this act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and
29 approval.
